Exhibition Dates: Wednesday, July 3 - Wednesday, July 28, 2019

Entry Form Due Date: May 3, 2019

Opening: No formal opening. Exhibition will open after mounting on July 3, 2019 and continue until closing on **Sunday, July 28, 2019.**

Drop-off: Wednesday, July 3, 2019 (9:30 - 10:30am) at Wyatt Hall, main entrance, City Hall

Pick-up: **Monday, July 29, 2019** (9:30 - 10:30 am) same location

Number of Entries: One piece

Note 1: The maximum number of pieces accommodated by the space (Wyatt Hall- stairway and landing area) will be established by the end of February.

Note 2: If you are unable to drop-off or pick-up your artwork at the appointed time, please make arrangements with another BASNL member or a friend/family to take care of your entry.

1. Conditions of Entry:

The exhibition is open to all Botanical Art Society of Newfoundland and Labrador (BASNL) members in good standing (dues paid). Non-members must apply and pay for membership in BASNL prior to sending an entry into the exhibition.

2. Criteria for Artwork:

- Entries must be two-dimensional original botanical art done on any ground that allows plant species identification and that adheres to BASNL's definition of botanical art as follows: *"Botanical art is the representation of the beauty of plant life in a manner that captures the essence of the plant. In botanical art, the plant is portrayed in a way that accurately depicts its image with reference to colour, scale, form and structure. Any stage of the plant can be rendered and may include details of leaves, stem, roots, flowers, seeds, fruit, spores, etc. The two sides of botanical art blend to combine scientific accuracy with the beauty of artistic expression."* (www.botanicalartsocietynl.com)
- Acceptable media include watercolour, coloured pencil, graphite, oil, acrylic, mixed media, water-soluble pencils, gouache, scratch board, ink and pastel. Photographic and computer-generated work is not acceptable.
- Concept, design, and execution of the artwork shall be solely by the artist. No work shall be based on copyrighted or published materials unless this work is done by the artist. Any photographic reference used for the entire or majority of the source must have been taken by the artist or used with permission from an alternate source.

3. Work may have been exhibited at a previous exhibition.

4. Artwork accepted for the exhibition must not exceed 1,140 square inches (e.g., 30" x 38") framed.

Framing: All work must be framed to a professional standard. Framed works must be matted in white, off-white or light grey and framed in a simple "L" profile (gallery) metal or wood frame of neutral colour (e.g. white, grey, black, gold, bronze, silver, or brown). Glass or plexiglass is acceptable.

Gallery wrapped canvases (oil and acrylic) are acceptable where staples are not visible. The sides of the canvas are prepared in the same manner as the face or front.

All work must be securely wired with wire appropriate for the weight of the work or with D-rings for heavier works. Saw-tooth hangers are not appropriate for any hanging systems for our exhibitions.

5. It is the artist's responsibility to ensure that accepted work is available during the exhibition dates.

6. Artwork will not be for sale but the artist contact information will be available on the artwork text card.

7. The artist, by submission, grants BASNL and the City of St. John's the right to use any jpeg images submitted by the artist for publicity, educational reference, and BASNL website purposes. Full credit will be given to the artist in any such case.

ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

Submitting entry form and text card information:

Each member is allowed to submit 1 artwork to available gallery space.

There is no entry fee; however, any shipping costs are the responsibility of the artist.

**The deadline for receipt of the entry forms and text card information is May 3, 2019.
Delivery deadline for framed art works is July 3, 2019**
